

First, log into myHill, then click on the MyHousing link located under the Orientation tab

Select the First-Year Student Housing Application from the pull-down menu, then click "Next"





Thank You... But Wait, There's More!

Thank you for submitting your online housing application. You are well on your way to being finished with the application process. You completed **Step 1: Completing your online housing application**.

Students requesting special housing accommodations for medical reasons must submit a separate written request to the Residence Life O request and all supporting primary medical documentation must be submitted by July 1st.

You should print a copy of this page, as well as any confirmation e-mails you receive throughout the housing application process, for you throughout the year.

Step 2: Make a specific roommate request (optional):

This process will allow you to place a roommate request for another Stonehill College student that has completed the online contract and by searching for them by name. It is very important to remember that all roommates must have submitted their online housing application are able to select each other as roommates. Students who submit mutual roommate requests will be placed together regardless of their perpendences. Often students meet someone they would like to live with when they are at summer orientation. To accommodate this, stude adjust their roommate requests until July 1st.

To make a roommate request, login to MyHousing the same way you logged in to complete your housing contract. Once you have completely login, select the MyHousing option on the "system select" menu. Once you are logged into MyHousing select the Roommate Selection of Room Selection menu on the Navigation bar on the left side. On this screen, you can search for and select roommates based on their Studies, or e-mail address. This screen will also display the status of your roommate requests and whether or not they have been accepted.

ALL roommate requests must be mutual in order for you to be assigned together.

Roommate Selection

- Although it is not required, you have the option of selecting roommates prior to room selection.
- The following slides will give you step-bystep instructions to guide you through this process.

Log back into MyHousing and choose the login option labeled "MyHousing."


Select this option if you wish to change personal/living preferences, participate in room selection, choose a dining plan, and more.






Click the "Room Selection" button in the lefthand column and select the option marked "Roommate Selection."
