Sample Project Ideas:

- Behavior change projects
- Educational awareness campaigns
- Attend off-campus seminars or conferences
- Energy reduction
- Improvement of a current process

Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed by the Environmental Stewardship Council's Green Fund Committee, which is comprised of faculty, students and staff and evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Measurable impact on energy use, waste reduction, water use, etc
- Cost savings resulting from resource conservation
- Innovation and creativity
- Visibility and reliability
- Educational value
- Quality of work plan

Rules:

- Stonehill students are eligible to apply.
- Staff and Faculty can be involved in partnership with students in project proposals.
- Individuals or teams can apply. Teams must designate one main contact for the application.
- Funding will be provided at the time of project implementation.
- Projects spanning more than one academic year must include a plan for continuity.
- Awarded funding typically ranges from \$100 - \$1,000; however, larger requests are also considered.

Expectations once the Green Fund project is complete:

- Provide a short summary of the project/event
- Provide photographs
- Submit invoices and receipts
- Provide advertisements or other media that were created as part of the project
