Open Enrollment – May 31st – June 21st Important Information and Date Sensitive Action *MAY BE* Needed

Beginning Friday May 31st, and continuing through Friday June 21st, benefit eligible employees are invited to make changes to or elect health, dental, vision or AFLAC (supplemental insurance) benefits. *Please be advised, if you are NOT making any changes, no action is needed at this time.*

Please remember that Open Enrollment is the one time during the year that you can make changes to your Health, Dental, Vision and AFLAC coverage without experiencing a Qualifying Event. Changes can include:

• Enrolling in, changing or terminating your Health, Dental, Vision and AFLAC coverage

Highlights include:

- NO changes to the employee contribution for health, dental or vision
- NO change to health copayment amounts (such as emergency room visits and office visits)
- Life/AD&D and Disability benefits are now being provided through Lincoln Financial Group.
 Stonehill will continue to provide this coverage to you at no cost

Benefit Enhancement: Health Insurance

- Smoking Cessation prescriptions will be covered at no member cost share on both medical plans
- Certain women's preventative health services will be covered at no member cost share on both medical plans
- Preventative/annual physicals with your primary care physician will be covered at no cost share on the HMO plan <u>ONLY</u>

Representatives from Tufts, Delta Dental, EyeMed and Aflac will be on campus on Wednesday, June 12, 2013 from 10 am to 1 pm in the Cleary Dining Room to answer any questions you may have about these benefits.
