## **Salmonellosis Information Sheet**

Cause: Salmonella spp.

Occurrence in animals: Most animals: mammals, birds, reptiles.

Source in animals: Feces.

**Exposure:** Accidental ingestion, both directly and indirectly

through contaminated objects.

## Symptoms:

• Animals: Diarrhea or asymptomatic, with intermittent shedding of bacteria in either case.

• Humans: Diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain.

#### **Precautions:**

- WASH HANDS after handling animals and their environment.
- Avoid hand-to-mouth contact.
- Use gloves to handle animals with diarrhea.
- Wear gloves, safety goggles and face mask when cleaning contaminated areas.
