SHARE Advisor Training

The SHARE Advisors are specially trained Stonehill Staff members who are available to students who have either experienced a sexual assault or students who have been accused of sexual assault. SHARE Advisors:

- 1. Assist with emergency rape crisis treatment and emergency medical services including accompanying the survivor to the hospital, police, etc. as requested.
- 2. Assist, guide and support throughout the College disciplinary process and/or the criminal justice process should the survivor choose to pursue this course of action.
- 3. Assist in referring academic concerns such as missed classes and/or assignments, or changing sections.
- 4. Assistance in contacting community resources such as rape crisis centers, support groups, etc. if desired.
- 5. General support and assistance as needed. It is always the survivor who chooses which services she/he would like to utilize.
