Checklist for Health-Related Requirements

Completed Health Form and Tuberculosis Risk Questionnaire to Health Services by June 28th

- ✓ Stonehill College does not require an appointment with your healthcare provider (PCP) for submission of forms. However, you may need an appointment to receive certain vaccines, if you are not already compliant with Massachusetts requirements for college-entry.

Massachusetts Department of Public Health Immunization Requirements to Health Services by June 28th

- ✓ Please submit immunization/laboratory documents with the Health Form by June 28th. Attach copy of immunization records, signed by your PCP, and any laboratory reports showing proof of immunity.

List of Required Immunizations:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella Vaccine (MMR): Two doses per appropriate dose schedule
Provide immunization documentation **OR** copy of laboratory test/proof of immunity

Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Vaccine (Tdap): One dose required within past 10 years
Consider booster to maintain compliance during all college years. Provide immunization documentation.

Hepatitis B Vaccine: Three doses per appropriate dose schedule
Provide immunization documentation **OR** copy of laboratory test/proof of immunity

Varicella Vaccine (chickenpox): Two doses per appropriate dose schedule
Provide immunization documentation **OR** copy of laboratory proof of immunity **OR** documentation of history of varicella disease (chickenpox) verified by healthcare provider

Meningococcal Meningitis Vaccine (MenACWY or MCV4): One dose is required for all full-time students 21 years of age or younger. The vaccination must be on or after the student's 16th birthday. Doses received at younger ages do not fulfill this requirement. This required meningitis vaccine provides protection for 4 of the 5 serogroups of meningitis (A, C, W, and Y).

* Please also ask your healthcare provider about getting the Meningitis B vaccine. The Meningitis B vaccine is not required by the state of Massachusetts, but is the only way to gain protection against meningitis serogroup B. We are promoting the message of awareness: "It Takes Two" vaccine types for full protection against this dangerous disease.

Tuberculosis Risk Questionnaire due by June 28th

- ✓ All students must complete the "Tuberculosis Risk Questionnaire".
If you screen as "high risk", your PCP must complete page 2 of the Tuberculosis Screening Questionnaire.

Massachusetts requires that all college students have health insurance

- ✓ Enroll in the Stonehill College Student Health Insurance Plan or waive it by providing proof of comparable health insurance coverage. The options to enroll or waive are usually available as of the first week of July. Details will be provided on the Health Services webpage in mid-June and at June Orientation.
