



## Amgen Scholars Program

The Amgen Scholars Program provides hundreds of undergraduate students with the opportunity to engage in a hands-on **summer** research experience at **10** of the world's leading universities. All host universities require a full-time commitment for **8-10 weeks**. Students will take part in important university **science** research projects, gain hands-on lab experience and contribute to the advancement of science; receive guidance from faculty mentors; and attend scientific seminars and workshops.

Though it is expected that the majority of Amgen Scholars will be science or engineering majors, students in any major may apply.

### Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- must U.S. citizens/U.S. permanent residents;
- must be undergraduate students enrolled in accredited four-year colleges/universities in the U.S., Puerto Rico or other U.S. territories;
- must be sophomores, juniors or non-graduating seniors (who are returning in the fall)
- must have a cumulative GPA of **3.20 or above**; and
- must have an interest in pursuing a Ph.D. or M.D.-Ph.D.

### Program Objectives:

- To increase learning and networking opportunities for undergraduate students pursuing **science or engineering** careers; and
- To broaden the perspective of undergraduate students **considering scientific careers**.

### Program Benefits

- Financial aid is a critical part of the program; room and board and travel expenses to/from the host university will be covered by each host university in accordance with their guidelines.

### Application Deadline

- Early February (California Institute of Technology is mid-February)
