What is Binge Drinking?

- O Binge drinking is when a person consumes an excessive amount of alcohol within a **short period of time**.
 - O For Men, **5** drinks in a row is equal to a Binge.
 - O For <u>Women</u>, **4** drinks in a row is equal to a Binge.







Statistics

- O Binge drinking is **more common among men** than women.
- O 90% of alcohol that is consumed by those under the age of 21 in the U.S. is in the form of binge drinks.



What is Considered a Drink?

- O 12 ounces of a Beer or Wine Cooler
- O 8 ounces of Malt Liquor
- O 5 ounces of Wine
- 1.5 ounces of 80 proof Hard Alcohol



Dangers of Binge Drinking



- Alcohol Poisoning
- O Liver Disease
- Neurological Damage
- O Unwanted Pregnancy
- Sexually Transmitted Diseases

Danger Signs of Alcohol Poisoning

- Vomiting
- Confusion
- Irregular heart beat
- Slow breathing
- O Pale/blue tinted skin
