



## Carnegie Junior Fellowship Program

Carnegie Junior Fellowships are awarded to ten uniquely qualified graduating **seniors**. Carnegie junior fellows work as **international relations research assistants** to the endowment's senior associates. They have the opportunity to conduct research for books, co-author journal articles and policy papers, participate in meetings with high-level officials, contribute to congressional testimony, and organize briefings attended by scholars, journalists, and government officials. Applicants may choose 1 of 10-12 programs or research topics.

Carnegie Junior Fellowships are **paid, full-time positions** for one year. Junior fellows are currently paid a gross salary of **\$3,083.33 per month** (\$37,000 per year).

### Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- must be graduating seniors or students who have graduated during the last academic year. (No one who has started graduate studies is eligible for consideration); and
- must be nominated by a participating institution.

### Selection Criteria

- Quality of the written essay
- Related academic study and/or work experience
- Grades
- Recommendations
- Personal interviews

### Application Deadline

- Mid January; Stonehill deadline may be early **November**
