Gilder Lehrman History Scholar Award

The Gilder Lehrman History Scholar Award recognizes 15 outstanding graduating college seniors in the U.S. who have demonstrated academic and extracurricular excellence in American history or American Studies as well as a commitment to public service and community involvement. Fifteen top American history college seniors will be selected as Gilder Lehrman History Scholar Award winners.

Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- must be considered graduating seniors in an accredited U.S. college or university. (Must have already graduated or expect to graduate by the end of the spring semester); and
- must be a history or American studies major with an American history concentration.

Award Benefits

- Spend a weekend in New York City, in early June.
- Participate in a program of special presentations, including meetings with leading scholars.
- Experience exclusive behind-the-scenes tours of historic archives.
- Receive the Gilder Lehrman History Scholar Award at a celebratory dinner hosted by the Gilder Lehrman Institute in New York City.
- Recipients will be reimbursed for up to \$600 for travel expenses to New York, and room and board will be provided during the award weekend.
