
Graduation Requirements

As a student you are responsible for tracking your requirements for degree completion and graduation. You have a Degree Audit available to you called myAudit . You can access myAudit in *myHill > myAcademics tab > "myAudit*". The Degree audit lays out all your General Education, Major(s), Minor(s), and Degree requirements in a graphical, color-coded series of blocks which make it easy to review your progress.

- 1. Students must complete all General Education requirements as well as the requirements for at least one declared Major.
- 2. Students must earn at least 124 credits to graduate. (At least 62 credits must be completed at Stonehill College.)
- 3. Students should normally fall within the credit ranges below to stay on track to graduate in the traditional 8 semesters.
 - a. End of first year = 31 credits
 - b. End of sophomore year = 62 credits
 - c. End of junior year = 93 credits
 - d. End of senior year = 124 credits
- 4. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 to graduate. (See graphic below)



5. Students must also earn a GPA of 2.00 in all declared majors and minors to graduate. (see graphic below)
