



## George J. Mitchell Scholarship

Up to twelve Mitchell Scholars are chosen annually for **one year** of postgraduate study in any discipline offered by higher education institutions in Ireland and Northern Ireland. The Mitchell Scholarship Program provides **tuition, accommodation, a stipend for living expenses and travel.**

*The Mitchell Scholarship Program, named to honor former U.S. Senator George Mitchell's pivotal contribution to the Northern Ireland peace process, is designed to introduce and connect generations of future American leaders to the island of Ireland, while recognizing and fostering intellectual achievement, leadership, and a commitment to community and public service.*

### Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- must be U.S. citizens;
- must be at least 18 years old, but not yet 30, on September 30 of the year of application; and
- must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university before beginning study as a Mitchell Scholar. Degrees from international accredited universities are acceptable, if all other conditions are met.

### Selection Criteria

- Scholarship/academic record
- Leadership
- A sustained commitment to community and public service

### Application Deadline

- Early October
