Global Health Corps provides a yearlong paid fellowship for young professionals from diverse backgrounds to work on the frontlines of the fight for global health equity at existing health organizations and government agencies. Fellows are currently working in Rwanda, Burundi, Uganda, Malawi, Zambia and the United States.

Fellows work in teams of two – one international fellow, one in-country fellow – to support placement organizations in improving healthcare access and health outcomes for the poor.

Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- Must have an undergraduate degree
- Be 30 or under
- Proficient in English

Selection Criteria

- Related academic study and/or work experience
- Grades
- Recommendations
- Personal interviews

Application Deadline

- Early February; Stonehill deadline may be early December
