

Residence Hall Occupancy Limits

To ensure the health and safety of all residents, Residence Life has identified the maximum number of individuals who may occupy a residence hall room and common area at any time. The design of a residence hall, traditional, suite, or village house, drives the identified maximum occupancy number to allow for safe egress in an emergency. Occupancy limits are based on building codes, square footage of each space, and building layouts, including space allotted for furniture.

Individual Residence Hall Rooms

Individual residence hall rooms have a maximum occupancy of eight (8) individuals in a standard double, triple, or quad. This includes the number of students living in the space.

Common Rooms & Lounges

The following common room and lounge spaces have a maximum occupancy of the following:

Bogan Hall	20
Colonial and Commonwealth Courts	40
Notre Dame du Lac	25
Pilgrim Heights	25
Pilgrim Heights Village & O'Hara Village	15

All occupancy limits must be strictly followed by all residents, their guests, and visitors. Violations of occupancy limits are subject to the community standards process.
