

Study Abroad and Financial Aid

Enrollment in a program of study abroad approved for credit by Stonehill College may be considered enrollment at Stonehill for the purpose of financial aid.

Are there additional costs associated with Study Abroad?

For the 24-25 academic year an abroad fee of \$750 per semester will be charged to students who choose to study abroad.

Will Study Abroad affect my financial aid award?

As a general rule, financial aid awards are applicable to study abroad programs approved by and administered through the College. Any awarded Stonehill scholarships, need-based grants, and other financial aid are valid for costs associated with studying abroad as long as the tuition/fees and any applicable room and board charges are billed by Stonehill directly to the student and payable to Stonehill. Tuition Exchange Scholarships, however, are not transferable.

How will I be billed?

Students in approved external programs will be charged for current Stonehill tuition and mandatory fees, plus Stonehill's room and/or board if the provider's advertised standard program costs include room and/or board. You will receive a bill from Stonehill, including your financial aid, and you must pay the balance due to Stonehill as you normally would.
