



Udall Undergraduate Scholarship

The Morris K. Udall and Stewart L. Udall Foundation awards **60** scholarships of up to **\$5,000** and 50 honorable mentions to **sophomore and junior** level college students committed to careers related to the **environment, tribal public policy, or Native American health care.**

Eligibility

Competitive Applicants:

- must be U.S. citizens, U.S. nationals, or U.S. permanent residents;
- must have college GPAs of at least a "B" or the equivalent;
- must be pursuing full-time study during the upcoming academic year;
- must be **sophomores or juniors**, enrolled full-time at a two-year or four-year U.S. accredited institution, pursuing a bachelor's/associate's degree, at time of application; and
- must be committed to a career related to the environment, to tribal public policy OR to Native American health care ***(only Native Americans and Alaska Natives are eligible to apply in tribal public policy or Native American health care)**

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrated commitment to environmental/natural resource issues OR tribal public policy OR Native American health care
- Course of study and proposed career likely to lead to position where nominee can significantly contribute to the shaping of either environmental policy, tribal public policy, or Native American health care issues (whether through scientific advances, public or political service, or community action)
- Leadership, character, desire to make a difference, general well-roundedness

Application Deadline

- Early March
